

Tussock House THREDBO, NSW

Tussock is a family retreat, nestled in the alpine village of Thredbo. The ground floor of the building is essentially sub-terranean with only one of the four elevations revealing itself to the viewer. The upper level is a pavilion structure, which sits in a field of Tussocks native grasses and flowers. The pavilion structure is substantially glazed, creating living areas with a sense of lightness and allowing filtered views of the surrounding alpine environment.

The entry is lit via flashing at the upper level, producing diffused light that filters through an open staircase and into the subterranean entry foyer. This creates an unexpectedly light and warm entry which then leads up into the pavillion spaces.
